Penalties

The Franchise Tax Board will challenge the claims of individuals who attempt to avoid or evade their tax liability by using form FTB 3525 in a manner other than as prescribed. Potential penalties for the improper use of form FTB 3525

- Accuracy-related penalties equal to 20% of the amount of taxes that should have been paid.
- Civil fraud penalties equal to 75% of the amount of taxes that should have
- ●A civil penalty for filing a frivolous tax return or submitting a specified frivolous submission as described by the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 19179 and Internal Revenue Code Section 6702.
