

Consent to Disclosure of Tax Return Information

(“we,” “us,” and “our”)

Printed name of tax preparer

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you (“you” refers to each taxpayer, if more than one). Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

You have indicated that you are interested in applying for a Refund Anticipation Loan and/or Bonu\$ Deposit Account product (collectively, a “bank product”) from JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. (“Chase”). In order to have your bank product application evaluated and processed by Chase, we must disclose all of your 2009 tax return information to Chase. You may request a more limited disclosure of tax return information, but you will not be eligible to submit a bank product application to Chase.

If you would like us to disclose your 2009 tax return information to Chase for this purpose, please sign and date your consent to the disclosure of your tax return information.

By signing below, you (including each of you if there is more than one taxpayer) authorize us to disclose to Chase all of your 2009 tax return information so that Chase can evaluate and process your application for a bank product. You understand that if you are not willing to authorize us to share your tax information with Chase, you will not be able to obtain a bank product from Chase, but you can still choose to have your tax return prepared and filed by us for a fee.
