

Earned Income Credit Worksheet - Form 1040 or 1040-SR, line 27

- 1. Enter the amount from Form 1040 or 1040-SR, line 1 plus any nontaxable combat pay elected to be included in earned income
2. If you received a taxable scholarship or fellowship grant that was not reported on a W-2 form, enter that amount here; plus any amounts received for work performed while an inmate in a penal institution; plus any amounts received as a pension or annuity from a nonqualified deferred compensation plan or a nongovernmental section 457 plan
3. Subtract line 2 from line 1
4. If you were self-employed or used Schedule C as a statutory employee, enter the amount from Worksheet B, line 4
5. Add lines 3 and 4
6. Look up the amount on line 5 above in the EIC Table right after Worksheet B in the instructions to find your credit. Enter the credit here. If line 6 is zero, stop. You cannot take the credit. Enter "No" directly to the left of Form 1040 or 1040-SR, line 27
7. Enter your AGI from Form 1040 or 1040-SR, line 11
8. Is line 7 less than -
- \$11,650 if you do not have a qualifying child? (\$17,600 if married filing joint)
- \$19,550 if you have at least one qualifying child? (\$25,500 if married filing joint)
Yes. Go to line 9 now.
No. Look up the amount on line 7 above in the EIC Table to find your credit. Enter the credit here
9. Earned income credit.
- If you checked "Yes" on line 8, enter the amount from line 6.
- If you checked "No" on line 8, enter the smaller of line 6 or line 8.
